You probably won't remember our family, but maybe 12 years ago you spoke with my wife and myself regarding Dr. Burzynski and his cancer treatment. Our son had been diagnosed with peripheral t-cell lymphoma. After speaking with you and visiting the Burzynski clinic, Mark started treatment using the oral anti-neoplastons. On our last visit to the Mayo clinic the lymphoma specialist was shocked that Mark was still alive. He said there was no way given his diagnosis years before that he should have survived. He called the pathologist to confirm the gene rearrangement studies from several years prior. His conclusion was Mark no longer has lymphoma! Mark still has medical issues and they remain a mystery, but he survived the lymphoma.
